The Importance of the Essay

As an applicant of the Security First Federal Credit Union annual scholarship program, you are required to submit an essay along with your application and other required documentation. The essay is a vital part of your submission, and all essays are read and scored by the Security First Federal Credit Union Scholarship Committee.

This committee personally reads and scores each essay using a rating scale matrix to ensure a consistent and fair scoring for all applicants. The following criteria will be considered:

THE ESSAY:

- Has a strong focus on the topic
- Conveys self-motivation
- Is structured
- Follows proper grammar structure
- Contains no misspellings

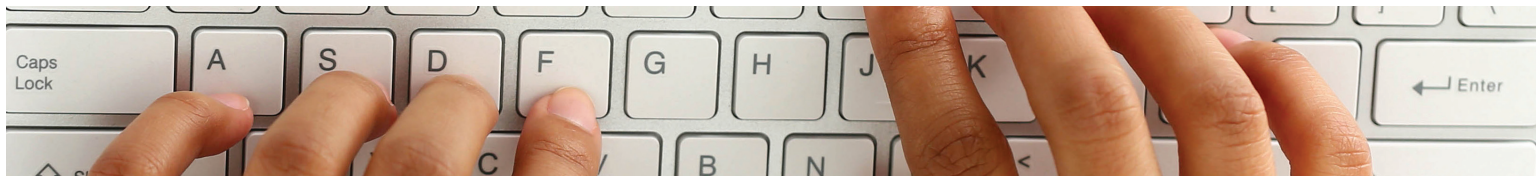
Who has been the most influential person in your life?

ESSAY REQUIREMENTS:

Must be typed with a maximum of 500 words. Please do not include your name in the essay. The essay must be submitted with the scholarship application.

The Basics of Essay Writing

As a refresher, below are the basic components of an essay. While working on yours, be sure to keep these key components in mind.

>> INTRODUCTION

The introduction of an essay establishes the essay's topic. It contains some general comments about the subject and your main message. A few pointers to consider when writing your introduction:

- Does the introduction relate to the essay question?
- Does the introduction contain your main message?
 - o Tip: The main message, also known as a thesis statement, is 1-2 sentences that describe what the essay is about and how the supporting points will be broken down. These supporting points should be reiterated in the Body of the essay in the same order.

>> BODY

The Body of an essay contains the main points, known as subtopics. Subtopics describe and support the essay's main points. Here is where you will write 1-2 paragraphs discussing your first point and so on. A few things to keep in mind:

- For the Security First Credit Union scholarship essay, you can include personal stories or Personal example to support your point.
- The last sentence of the paragraph should be transitional and take the reader into the next point.

>> CONCLUSION

The conclusion of an essay is the last paragraph and is used to summarize statements, a reiteration of your main message, and include your final thoughts.

>> FINAL REVIEW AND EDITING

Before submitting your essay, it is best to review it once completed. This is the time to make any changes or corrections. Other things to keep in mind are:

- Proofreading
- Read your essay out loud
- Make sure you are following the instructions listed on the Security First Credit Union scholarship application.
